The Farm is a 24-acre certified organic mixed vegetable farm in BC that has grown into a successful business over the past 30 years. This firmly established family farm has a strong following at year-round farmer's markets in the communities of Salmon Arm and Revelstoke. Produce is also shipped weekly to organic home delivery services. Over the years the farm has developed to include 13 high tunnels and a large, heated house for seedling production. They have also developed a large packing/storage facility which allows their employees to work comfortably and efficiently while enabling appropriate storage conditions for a wide diversity of crops. They generally employ a crew of 12 full-time employees through the growing season (May to October) and 5 full-time employees to carry the farm through the winter market season.

They are seeking energetic individuals with a keen interest in growing organic food to join the farm team. The work varies from week to week and will include transplanting, weeding, harvesting and preparation of produce for market, among other tasks.

- Have good physical fitness
- Enjoy working outdoors

- Don't mind getting your hands dirty
- Enjoy working as part of a team to meet deadlines
- Positive attitude despite the adverse conditions that outdoor work often involves
