Company & Job Details:

This company is family owned as well as operated and get its start in the forage business in 1993. It has become a family venture with the three eldest sons joining the team over the past ten years. They harvest about 15000 acres forage and 20 grains. 3000 acres corn silage and 100,000 3x4x8 straw bales. As a Canadian producer, processor, and exporter they specialized in timothy hay, non-GMO alfalfa hay, wheat and barley straw, dehydrated barley silage and dehydrated corn silage. They also grow and harvest grain for their own or local use – wheat, peas, mustard etc. To optimize the weight for export the company introduced a dehydration line which means that they have several presses to compress hay, straw and dehydrate silage into bales.

- General farm work like seeding, harrow packing, rolling, spraying, cutting, racking, baling, chopping, combining, operating, and maintaining agricultural machinery
- Mechanical and maintenance work in our shop for vehicles and machinery
- Construction and maintenance work in the yard operating and maintaining construction machinery
