The farm is seeking a full-time individual to join their team. The ideal candidate has a background and/or interest in agriculture, they are a self-starter, demonstrate a strong work ethic and have the ability to problem solve on the fly.

The farm is a modern and forward thinking family-run grain/arable farm and broiler chicken operation near Beaverton Ontario. They farm 2000 acres (800 hectares) of corn, soybeans and wheat, which is sold off farm. Chicken production for meat consists of 20,000 chickens every ten weeks. They use progressive farming practices such as no-till, strip-till and cover cropping and they strive for continued sustainability in all aspects of our farming operation. They own, operate and maintain all planting and harvesting machinery/equipment.

A sunflower agriculture-tourism business is operated in the summer months as a farm diversification business. This additional farm operation grows sunflowers for birdseed production and opens the farm to the general public for events throughout the summer (music, car shows, floral workshops, etc.) Opportunities to gain experience with this operation is optional.

What you will do/learn to do:

- Complete field work with minimal supervision (tillage, spraying, planting, etc.)
- Scout fields throughout the cropping season and gather soil samples for testing
- Actively contribute to harvest operations (buggy operator, combine operator, monitor grain dryer, etc.)
- Assist with maintenance and upkeep of large equipment
